SCHOLARSHIP Program

It is a FULL-TUITION Academic Scholarship program offering to students of exceptional merit and those who need financial aid in their pursuit of harp education. Pending on the assessment of each application, the Scholarship could also provide a free harp for practice at home purpose. Students aged between 9 - 16 could apply for a Special Scholarship Fund for overseas training opportunity.

APPLICATION QUALIFICATIONS – ‘general’ guidelines:



1. Aged between 5 – 16, Hong Kong resident
2. Household Income <HK\$200,000 per annum AND Household Assets <HK\$1,000,000
3. Priority would be given to students with music knowledge, demonstrated musicality and vocal capabilities
4. Personal Characteristics: a commitment to practice and continuous improvement, vivid imagination, courage and emotional power, ability to work as a part of an ensemble including the strength of sustained concentration

APPLICATION process

- Application : Apply through participating schools or submit individual application directly to ‘Friends of the Harp’
- An Admission Board will assume full authority for the whole selection process and the final decision
- Applicants may be required to come for an interview before the Scholarship is granted

COURSE STURCTURE

1. Course Duration: A **10-12 hour course in 3 months** (including lessons & tutorial sessions)
 - A 5-person group class x 2 groups, 2-hr per class, 2 classes +2 tutorial sessions per group per month (Course schedule can be tailored-made to individual participating schools’ need)
 - Teaching Venue (At Friends of the Harp or at Participating Schools)
2. Students’ progress would be assessed to determine how the course would proceed further
